

Your goal of attending Huntington Junior College is to start a new career when you graduate. Our goal is to help you obtain the knowledge, skills, and habits that will make you a successful employee. One of the most important habits you will have as an employee is punctuality on your job.

At Huntington Junior College, you are allowed to miss 25% of the scheduled class time before you may be administratively dropped for lack of attendance. For many, this equals a certain number of class days. On classes that meet three days a week (first through fourth period on M/W/F) 25% equals six days. On classes that meet two days a week (all classes on T/TH and fifth period on M/W) 25% equals four days. On classes that meet once a week (night school and online classes) 25% equals two days.

In order to help you develop the habit of punctuality, many instructors will monitor and report tardiness. The minutes missed will count towards your overall attendance. If you miss more than 25% of the class time, even if it is just by arriving late or leaving early, you may be administratively withdrawn.
