

### **Number of majors students can attempt at Huntington Junior College**

Students can change majors during their first 48 attempted hours at the college with financial and academic counseling. After attempting 48 hours, students may change majors only one time. If they have already changed majors after attempting 48 hours, they must complete one of the degrees they have been previously enrolled in.

As a graduate a student may add one additional major after receiving financial and academic counseling. If the second degree does not provide an economic benefit to the student, HJC retains the right to refuse enrollment until student has actively looked for work for six months.

If a student is required to complete an externship/practicum as part of the first degree, they must first complete the externship/practicum prior to enrolling in a second major. (Effective 1/1/11)
